Well the indoor season is almost over and spring is just around the corner (dream on).

Expenses:

A reminder to all officials that if you have any expenses to claim for 2013 or the 2014 indoor season you should submit them to our treasurer Rene Van Andel, rene.vanandel@gmail.com, immediately as the books close for the fiscal year on April 1st.

Availability:

Attached is our availability list for the outdoor season. Please email your availability to Ian Reid as soon as possible. Remember that if you indicate your availability now and life gets in the way please contact Ian as soon as you know about your change in plans. We will try to send out invitations and information at least 3 weeks in advance of the meet. We will also contact you if your services are not needed. If in doubt please contact Ian or myself, don't assume that you are not needed.

Response to the request for officials for the Pan Am CE Cup and AO Jr/Sr Championships in Ottawa was very pleasing and somewhat overwhelming. We will be contacting officials regarding their selection for those meets in the near future. With the selection process so far in advance we ask that any officials not selected be patient as you will be considered as alternates should the need arise. With so many officials travelling to Ottawa from various parts of the province, we will be requesting that, if at all possible, officials travel together to decrease costs. Our plan at this time is to offset the extra cost of officials' accommodation by the savings from carpooling. We would like to invite as many officials as possible to at least one of the AO Championships.

Cancelling from a Meet

We understand that circumstances sometimes require an official to cancel from a meet to which he/she has previously committed. If this is ever your situation, please remember to advise both the meet organizer, and Ian Reid, the AOO Director of Availability. This allows adjustments to the roster of officials and, in the case of out-of-town officials, the cancellation of any hotel reservations. Your cooperation in this matter is much appreciated.

Travel expenses:

The policy for paying expenses is covered in the document, "Organization and Operation of the AOOEC and AOO" which can be found on the AO web site at <http://athleticsontario.ca/wp-content/uploads/2013/04/AO-Officials-document-SEP-21-2013.pdf>

In brief, expenses are paid only for registered officials, according to the following guidelines:

- Funding for officials' travel to AO championships at the AO-approved rate is restricted to registered officials who are Level 2 or higher.

- Registered Level 1 officials are eligible for funding to a maximum of 50 km each way. (NOTE, if the meet is within 'commuting distance', funding is available for each day of the meet [e.g. Oshawa to Toronto for 2-day meet = funding for 200 km; Toronto to Ottawa for 2-day meet = funding for 100 km])
- Registered Provisional officials receive no funding for travel unless approved in advance by the AOOEC.

Officials' Uniform:

The standard uniform for track and field officials is a white collared shirt, golf shirt, or blouse, and navy slacks, skirt or long shorts, with a white or navy jacket, sweater or vest as required. Neither jeans nor sandals are considered appropriate. An Athletics Ontario official receives a name tag upon becoming level 1 and an AO golf shirt after achieving level 2.
