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## **Overview**

Athletics Ontario is inviting Coaches to apply for a position on Team Ontario for the 8<sup>th</sup> Annual ON vs. QC Midget Dual Meet. The competition will be held February 9<sup>th</sup> at the Toronto Track and Field Centre. Athletes will compete in a friendly competition against Team Quebec.

## **General Information**

Applications for coaching positions within Athletics Ontario teams will be called from current active Athletics Ontario Coaches who are accredited through the Coaching Association of Canada and Athletics Ontario. An active coach is defined as the coach responsible for preparing and supervising the training and competition programs for Athletics Ontario athletes.

### Positions Available

1. Head Coach
2. Endurance Coach
3. Throws Coach
4. Jumps Coach
5. Sprints/Hurdles Coach

## **Coach Responsibilities**

1. Be experienced at the appropriate level and actively coaching in the same event in which he/she is applying to coach
2. Be responsible for preparing team athletes in the event group for which he/she was chosen to achieve the best possible result
3. Submit, following the event, a report covering his/her area of responsibility and recommendations
4. Be actively involved in the selection and documentation of athletic team members
5. Attend all staff meetings, trials meet (Jan. 19-20, 2019) and Championship
6. Be willing to work cooperatively with other members of the Team Staff
7. Take on additional duties as requested by the Head Coach or AO where required
8. Supervision of athletes on the day from the initial meeting to the completion of the last event
9. Conduct themselves appropriately as representatives of AO and the province of Ontario.

10. Have a strong commitment to the team aspect of the competition - uphold team expectations and report any problems to the Head Coach - be willing to undergo a screening process, including police checks, as requested.
11. Must be a registered AO Coach at the time of selection and through the end of the team event
12. Be publicly supportive of AO policies and programs
13. Must be in good standing with AO and the Coaches Association of Ontario

**Head Coach** – assisting in the creation of information memos for athletes and staff, leading all staff and athlete meetings, and the submission of protests as required

### **Selection Factors**

1. Must be minimum Club Coach “Trained”
2. Event Specific Coaching Certification is an asset
3. Be experienced at the appropriate level and actively coaching in the same event in which he/she is applying to coach
4. Gender Equity
5. Language Diversity
6. Team player with the ability to adhere to Athletics Ontario’s team objectives and policies
