**Summary**

The draft criteria for 2018-2019 was posted in June of 2018. The final criteria was posted in December 2018.

Sixty-three (63) athletes received Quest for Gold funding in the 2018-19 cycle. These were broken down as follows:

- 42 Full Cards
- 18 Half Cards
- 3 Injury Cards
- 3 Para Cards



## Issues

### Criteria & Applications

- Similar to the 2017-18 carding cycle, revised criteria was posted and reviewed by membership prior to the start of the outdoor season, however the release of the final criteria was delayed. This resulted in a very quick turnaround for applications, evaluations, etc. in order to have it completed prior to the Ministry's year end of March 31, 2019.
