Summary

This past year can only be described as chaotic for the AO Technical Committee. The Committee had three Chairs at the helm which provided for many challenges. Unfortunately, the Committee membership seemed fluid based and driven by issues at hand rather than a work plan. With the chaotic year, most Committee members missed at least one meeting, mainly due to the last minute nature of the meeting call AND a perceived lack of value and input by the members.

The Committee instituted the use of an AO Records Form to bring some discipline to Record Submissions. In previous years AO has relied on a manual process of scanning papers or online for results and comparing against record sheets or memory. It was suggested that the onus should be similar to the Canadian Masters, AC and IPC process, which would transfer the obligation to the athlete and coach.

The Technical Committee conducted a Members online survey of Hurdle / Endurance Coaches with respect to rule changes for 3000mS/C, 5000m; Youth B and G 400mH; YG YB 5000mW; YB Decathlon. The results were tabulated and served as the basis of recommendations to the Committee in June.
