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2017 Canada Summer Games

Overview

Winnipeg is set to host the Jeux de Canada Summer Games. Featuring 16 sports, over 250 events and a major cultural festival, the 2017 Canada Games will welcome over 4,000 athletes and coaches and more than 20,000 visitors. The Athletics events will be July 30 – August 4, 2017. Athletics Ontario is seeking nominations from members interested in serving on the Coach staff as a **Sprints/Hurdles event Coach.**

General Information

Applications for coaching positions within Athletics Ontario teams will be called from current active Athletics Ontario Coaches who are accredited in the National Coaching Association and Athletics Ontario. An active coach is defined as the coach responsible for preparing and supervising the training and competition programs for Athletics Ontario athletes.

All Staff Must

1. Be experienced at the appropriate level and actively coaching in the same event in which he/she is applying to coach
2. Be responsible for preparing team athletes in the event group for which he/she was chosen to achieve the best possible result
3. Submit, following the Games, a report covering his/her area of responsibility
4. Be actively involved in the selection and documentation of athletic team members
5. Attend all staff meetings, team camps, selection meets and the 2017 Games – Note: attending 2016 Florida March Break Training Camp, in Clermont, FL is an asset
6. Be willing to work cooperatively with other members of the Team Staff
7. Take on additional duties as requested by the Head Coach or AO where required
8. Assist with supervision and management of the Team on and off the competition venue
9. Conduct themselves appropriately as representatives of AO and the province of Ontario
10. Have a strong commitment to the team aspect of the competition - uphold team expectations and report any problems to the Head Coach - be willing to undergo a screening process, including police checks, as requested.





2017 Canada Summer Games

Event Coach will:

1. Be a current registered Coach of Athletics Ontario
2. Accredited in the National Coaching Certification Program (NCCP)
3. Minimum Performance Coach Trained (Level 3) Sprints/ Hurdles
4. Be a member in good standing
5. Adhere to the [Coaches Code of Conduct](#)
6. Must declare for coaching position
7. Supervise all competitions and practices in his/her event group
8. Meet with event group athletes and outline team expectations
9. Be knowledgeable of the physical condition of athlete team members leading up to and during the Games and be ready to make recommendations for changes in entries as required
10. Be aware of rules, facilities and equipment in the event group area and use this knowledge to assist athletes to achieve best possible results

Team Selection Guidelines

Applications will be reviewed and assessed by a committee approved by the AO BOD. The Head Coach is added to this committee for the selection of other coaches and managers.

Selection Factors

Areas Considered for Team Staff Selection (no particular order)

1. Must be minimum Performance Coach Trained
2. Event Specific Coaching Certification is an asset
3. Be experienced at the appropriate level and actively coaching in the same event in which he/she is applying to coach
4. Gender Equity
5. Language Diversity
6. Team player with the ability to adhere to Athletics Ontario's team objectives and policies
11. Ability to attend 2016 Florida March Break Training Camp - Clermont is an asset
