April 14th, 2020 – Final review of applications prior to Ministry submission.

April  $16^{\text{th}}$ , 2020 – Review of appeals received by Ministry, and prepared committee responses.

April 21st, 2020 – Appeal response submitted to the Ministry.

### **Summary**

The draft criteria for 2019-2020 was posted in May of 2019. The final criteria was posted in March 2020 due to Ministry delays pertaining to COVID-19.

Sixty-three (68) athletes received Quest for Gold funding in the 2019-20 cycle. These were broken down as follows:

- 35 Full Cards
- 23 Half Cards
- 7 Injury Cards
- 3 Para Cards
