Mentorship Pairings

Officials professional development is facilitated by ongoing mentorship from a suitably qualified, experienced official. Mentoring is discipline specific. An official must be recommended for an upgrading evaluation by their assigned mentor. Allocation of mentors is ongoing. Phase 1 has concentrated on development of level 2 officials by their mentors and has resulted in a number of successful level 3 upgradings. An absence of a mentor at level 3 and above will not prevent consideration for level 4 / 5 upgrading evaluations as we continue to adopt the mentoring structure.
